
TRANSFER FROM TEMPLATES




- Begin by printing out the template. For smaller sizes, simply use the Scale option to scale down the template in the Print Dialog box.
- 2. Cut out all of the templates.
- 3. Completely cover the entire back of the template piece with a thick, dark layer of pencil.
- 4. Arrange the template over your rock, pencil side down. Secure with tape.
- 5. Firmly trace the template with a pen.
 Peel a small corner of the template off to
 make sure the pencil is transferring to
 the rock.

- 6. If the design does not transfer, remove the template and layer over the back of the template with a softer pencil. Then repeat step 5.
- 7. Once the template is transferred, remove the paper and tape and paint.
- 8. **TIP:** If painting multiple colors, save the template, coat once again with pencil and re-apply the template over each coat of paint to keep the details visible.






