

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DISNEYLAND ENTRY GATES

Sheet Numbers: 1A, 1B, 1C, 2A, 2B, 2C, 3 & 4

HISTORY

Nothing signifies the beginning of a Disneyland day like walking through the turnstiles under the Main Gate pavilions.

Traditionally, the gates are adorned with giant pumpkins for Halloween. Each one is an artistic endeavor involving hours of carving, sanding, finishing, and painting to bring the Fab 5 to life in pumpkin form.

Welcome, Foolish Mortals, to Disney Paper Parks: Happy Haunts Edition.

MATERIALS CUIDE Lines Valley fold, fold in front Mountain fold, fold behind Cut X-ray or guide line.

Please Note: When cutting with scissors and working with any of the materials listed above, adult participation and supervision is recommended.

INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Color all the sheets as you like.
- 2. Cut out all pieces from Sheet 1A / 2A. Note: Since these are a pair, sheets 1A, 1B, and 1C are the same as 2A, 2B, and 2C. The instructions will be the same for both.
- 3. For the ceiling piece, fold all edges down and apply glue to the corners. Use the trip detail to wrap the edges, ensuring that they line up with the bottom and stick up over the top. Set aside.
- 4. Cut out all pieces from sheet 1B / 2B. Fold along the lines and glue the edges. Apply drops of glue to adhere the corners of the long roof to the ceiling piece. Using the labels as guides, place the small roofs on the long roof and glue the tabs to the ceiling piece to secure.
- 5. Cut out all pieces on sheet 1C / 2C. Fold and glue as indicated. Use the guidelines on the ceiling to help place the gates. Glue the tops of the gates to the bottom of the ceiling.
- 6. Cut out the pieces on sheets 3 & 4. Tip for the small crown: to make the inside cuts easier, fold along the lines first, then cut the diagonal lines, unfold, and cut the rest out. If you would like to swap out the decorations in the future, we recommend using tape instead of glue.
- 7. For the larger pumpkins: fold and glue the tops together. Add the duck bills. Glue onto the roof. Your entry gates are now complete!



- . Color the pages with crayons, colored pencils, or whatever you would like to use.
- 2. Cut along solid lines where indicated.
- 3. Fold tabs and pieces according to Guide.
- 4. Cut the plastic straw to measure approximately 4 inches. Take piece 2 (bat back) and tape the plastic straw to the inside of the bat as shown in image 1.
- 5. Glue both sides of the bat together at the base of the wings and the head/ feet, with the straw inside to add depth to the head and body.
- 6. Attach any paper chain you want to the bats wings, using the open connection detail at the wing ends on piece 2. See image 2.
- 7. Pieces 4 through 7 are other paper chain designs to use. Make multiple copies and have fun mixing the patterns together to form long paper chain swags.
- 8. For the "Welcome Foolish Mortal" signs, pieces 9, 10 and 11. Attach to any paper chain design using piece 8 as shown in image 3.









SOME IMPORTANT TIPS!


- Use paper straws (or bamboo skewers) to make the paper stiff. We recommend gluing it to the back, but tape works as well.
- If you have a hole punch, that works well for cutting eyes for the ghosts.
- If there is a central piece that's difficult to cut, you can cut through the exterior and tape it up again! The important thing is the shadow it casts, so it's perfectly fine if the puppet looks a little messy.



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
