




# HISTORY



# ENCHANTED STORYBOOK CASTLE

Plan and Castle Base Sheet Numbers: A, B, C, D + 1, 2, 3

# INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Color the sheets as you like.
- 2. Lay out the sheets according to the guide above. This will be where you place each of the buildings on the Plan. You can tape the sheets together or leave them loose for easy storage later.
- 3. For the base (Sheets 1 2): Cut and fold wherever indicated. Apply glue as shown. Glue Base Part 1 to Base Part 2. Construct the Stage and slip under the opening in Base Part 2. Glue Front Towers to front of Base Part 2.
- 4. Sheet 3: Cut, fold, and glue East Bridge and West Bridge as indicated. Using the longer flap, glue to the angled edges of Base Part 2. Glue Rockwork pieces to their corresponding sides around the Base.


Please Note: When cutting with scissors and working with any of the materials listed above, adult participation and supervision is recommended.




Castle Exterior Sheet Numbers: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

**INSTRUCTIONS** 

- 1. Color the pages anyway you like.
- 2. Cut along solid lines where indicated.
- 3. Fold all tabs and pieces according to Guide.
- 4. For the Castle Exterior (Sheets 4 8): Begin with the South Facade (Sheet 4). Glue Piece 1 to Piece 2 as noted. Glue the edges of the towers (Pieces 6a and 6b) to Piece 1 where indicated. Tape Piece 4b to Piece 4 and Piece 5b to Piece 5 to create the small turret corners. Glue Piece 4 to the right side of Piece 2 and glue Piece 5 to the left side of Piece 2.
- 5. Sheet 5: Fold and glue Piece 3 back to back. We recommend glueing a craft stick or toothpick between the tall towers to keep it up straight. Line up the edge of Piece 5 and Piece 4 where indicated on Piece 3 and glue.
- 6. Construct the East Facade (Sheet 6): Construct Piece 3. Glue the left tab on Piece 7 where noted on Piece 3. Attach the left side of Piece 8 to the right tab of Piece 3. Fold edges of Piece 9 and glue where indicated on Piece 8. Glue Piece 10 where indicated on Piece 8. Set aside Piece 12 for the North Facade.
- Construct the North Facade (Sheet 7): Construct Piece 11 in a similar way to Piece 3, adding toothpicks or craft sticks if needed. Glue left edge of Piece 11 to right edge of Piece 8. Glue tabs from Pieces 12, 13, and 15 as noted. Glue Piece 13a to Piece 13.
- Construct the West Facade (Sheet 8): Glue right side tabs of Piece 14 to Piece 15. Glue piece 15a to Piece 15. Glue edges to North and South Facade tabs. Attach piece 17 to Piece 13. Glue the edge of piece 7 to the back of Piece 11 where indicated.






## **INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. Color the pages anyway you like.
- 2. Cut along solid lines where indicated.
- 3. Fold all tabs and pieces according to Guide.
- 4. Sheet 9, piece 17: Assemble castle interior by gluing the tabs on the ceiling to the walls. Then glue the bottom wall tabs to the underside of the flooring circle to form the base.
- 5. For pieces 18a, 18b, and 18c: Using glue stick, glue all three sides of the chandelier together, then glue to ceiling center tip as shown in image.
- 6. Sheet 10: Assemble interior tower shroud by gluing the tabs to the back walls. Glue the back tips of the tower tops together. Cut a toothpick in half and glue to the inside of the small turret and glue to the side of the tower. Next glue the window wall to the outside of each end as shown in image.
- 7. Glue interior to shroud and place in the center of the castle as shown in image.
- 8. Feel free to place Mickey and Minnie in the Stair Hall or right on stage in front of your finished Enchanted Storybook Castle!





Model view of Stair Hall























Left Tower Piece 6a Right Tower Piece 6b


