Additionally, we will donate a portion of the event proceeds to the Sports Legacy of the SF&OC's "Disney All-Star Sports Academy" and the Hong Kong Federation of Handicapped Youth's "HKFHY Momentum Academy," aiming to cultivate the athletic potential of children and youth while fostering inclusion among diverse groups. The event will also continue to feature an Inclusive 3K Run, inviting participants with disabilities to join alongside others. Our team has ensured that the event follows environmentally friendly practices.

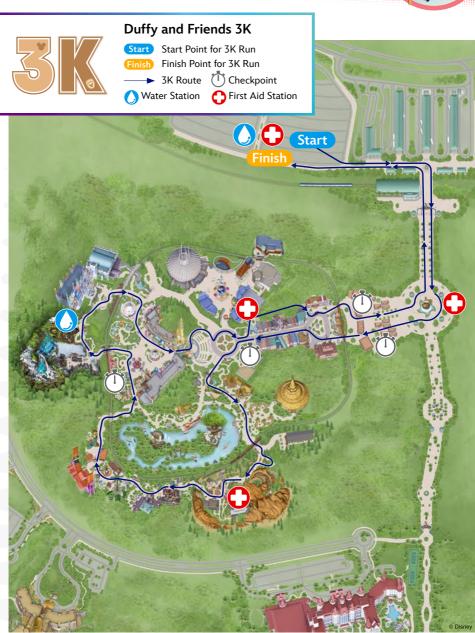

Details

Time:	9:00AM – 11:00AM
Age:	Aged 5 or below (subject to height and weight restriction of each game)

All Child Participants MUST wear their running bibs on their chest and their wristband before entering the Security Check area. All Companions (including Accompanying Participants) MUST also wear their wristbands before entering the Security Check area. Otherwise, the Organizers reserve the right to disqualify the participants concerned and deny them entry to the park area.

Each Child Participant enrolled in "Mickey & Friends Junior Races" will have 3 wristbands.

- One [Child Participant] wristband to access the running route and Activity Zone,
- One [Accompanying Participant] (Aged 18 or above) wristband to access the running route and Activity Zone
- One [Companion] wristband to enter the Tomorrowland Activity Zone without participating in the race
- * Only Junior Race Participants are allowed to participate in the activities located in the Activity Zone, apart from the Disney-Style Runway Awards.

Must wear their running bibs and wristband before entering the Security Check area and during all activities.

Last entry to Security Check will be 10:30AM.

Terms and Conditions

- · Lost or damaged bib and/or wristband will not be replaced.
- The wristband and admission to the Activity Zone are non-transferrable, non-exchangeable, revocable and not for re-sale.
- Each eligible Child Participant must be accompanied and supervised by his/her parent or legal guardian aged 18 or above at all times in the Activity Zone.
- Participation in each game of the Activity Zone is subject to rules and regulations for such game. Please refer to the on-site notice or signage of each game for details.
- Eligible Child Participant and their parent or legal guardian should follow the instructions of the officials and Cast Members at all times in the Activity Zone. The Organizers reserve the right to deny admission, or to require a person already admitted to leave the Activity Zone, without refund or compensation, for failure to comply with any rules, regulations or instructions, for unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior, to ensure safety, security or order, or if the Organizers consider that the circumstances so require.

Please provide your running bib for identification when registering. The photo cannot be changed or adjusted after submission. Participants must complete the relevant competition in the registered appearance.

Costume Requirements

- The running bib must be clearly displayed in front of the Participants' chest.
- · Costumes must be Disney-themed.
- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, objectionable, offensive or violent to other Participants.
- Costumes may not contain any weapons which resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects or materials that could accidentally strike other Participants.
- Costumes may not drag on the ground.
- Certain accessories, such as full-face masks and helmets, must be removed before taking selfie photos with Disney Characters.
- · Participants who dress like Characters may not pose for pictures or sign autographs for other persons.

For everyone's safety, full-face masks must provide unobstructed peripheral vision at all times with openings that allows the eyes to be fully seen when worn by Participants. Participants should also consider if such a full-face mask is suitable for wearing in the Race.

Participants who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into, and/or removed from, a Race or any Race-related activities unless their costume can be modified to meet the above standards.

Each Participant, whether individual or part of a team, may enroll only once per Event day. Any duplicate applications will be canceled by the Organizers without notice.

Disney-Style Runway Awards



Selection Criteria

Participants will be judged based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- · Integrated Disney Elements
- Merging of creativity and comfortableness (suitable for run)
- · Eye-catching
- · Demonstration of personality
- Team collaboration

Judging Process

Judging for the "Disney-Style Runway Awards" will be conducted by a representative from Hong Kong Disneyland Resort and/or a representative invited by Hong Kong Disneyland Resort. Selected finalists must attend the Ceremony at the Event Center/Tomorrowland on time. The champion in each group will be selected at the ceremony.

Results

The list of the selected finalists for the "Disney-Style Runway Awards" will be displayed at the Registration Booth in the Event Center/Tomorrowland. Participants are required to check the results on the event day, as organizers will not notify finalists individually. Finalists who are shortlisted must assemble in costume at the Main Stage in the Event Center/Tomorrowland on the day of the event. Finalists who are absent from the ceremony will be disqualified without further notice.





Important Notes

- a. Health Questionnaire



You should appreciate that taking part in any of the races at the Event can be a strenuous exercise. Your health should always take priority and therefore you should only participate if you are physically fit and have been adequately prepared.

If you intend to take part in Hong Kong Disneyland 10K Weekend - 20th Anniversary Party Edition - Presented by AIA Vitality (the "Event"), you should read the questions below carefully and answer each one of them honestly. You are not required to return the completed questionnaire, but we encourage you to use it to assess your physical condition, and seek medical advice as appropriate to decide whether you should participate in the Event.

Health Recommendations



You should appreciate that taking part in any of the races of the Event can be a strenuous exercise and that you should only run on the day if you have been adequately prepared. If you notice any unusual symptoms that may develop during the race, e.g., Chest pain, dizziness, severe nausea, unusual shortness of breath, change in your running style, confusion and disorientation, you should stop running and seek medical attention immediately. Although you may feel it is more important to finish the race, remember that it is your health that should always take priority.

Any person who is pregnant or suffering from any chronic disease such as heart disease or high blood pressure, or is suffering from or has any symptoms of any contagious disease, should not participate in the Event.

Here are a few recommended "Dos" and Don'ts":





Listen to your body



Eat if necessary



Take care of your health

Run if you are not fit enough or not properly prepared



Take ANY medication during the race



Run if you have been sick or on antibiotics in the three weeks prior to the race



Be embarrassed or afraid to stop and seek medical attention

Information Announcement on Event Day

Weather Tips

Pay attention to the weather forecast report from the Hong Kong Observatory at home before proceeding the event location.

Inclement Weather Arrangements

The Event will be cancelled if tropical cyclone warning signal no.3 or above, and/or red or black rainstorm signal is hoisted by the Hong Kong Observatory at 3:00AM.

In all other inclement weather scenarios not specified above, the Organizers may in their sole discretion delay, suspend or cancel the Event, any Race and any ancillary entertainment activities and facilities. Such scenarios include without limitation thunderstorm warning and/or 10KM lightning warning hoisted after the cut off time; and damage or obstruction to facilities, venue or route caused by inclement weather prior to the Event. Announcements concerning delay, suspension and cancellation will be published on the Event official website.

Please pay special attention to the weather report during the 16-hour period before the Race start time as it may indicate whether tropical cyclone warning signals, or red or black rainstorm signals are likely to be hoisted. Please also follow the updates at Event Official Website closely regarding the status of the Event.

No refund of entry fee or other compensation will be provided if the Event, any Race and/or any ancillary entertainment activities and facilities are delayed, suspended or cancelled due to inclement weather.

Gear Checklist



All Participants must bring the items listed below and they will not be re-distributed on the event days:

Running Bib with Timing Chip

Participants should wear the running bib with timing chip on their chests to enable officials to identify their race numbers. Otherwise, the Organizers reserve the right to disqualify the Participant concerned.

- Use the four pins included in the Runner's Pack, attach the running bib to all four corners of their tops, with the race number facing outward.
- · Do not fold or remove the timing chip.
- Participants need to pass through the timing points located at the Start, Finish and other checkpoints. Otherwise, results will not be provided.
- · Running bib and timing chip are non-transferable.
- Participants should start in the designated race and time. No results, commemorative medals nor E-certificates will be issued to participants who started in the wrong race/time.
- To assist the Organizers and medical personnel to contact participants' relatives or friends in case of emergencies, participants are required to fill in their personal details on the back of their running bibs (participant's name, emergency contact person and phone number, etc.) with waterproof ink. For bib layout and race day key times, please refer to page 8-9.

Junior Races running bibs do not have a timing chip.

Participants not wearing a valid running bib for the for the "Hong Kong Disneyland 10K Weekend - 20th Anniversary Party Edition - Presented by AIA Vitality" will be debarred from running by officials.

Running Apparels and Tips

Running Shirt - Running Shirts made of polyester are suitable because they are lightweight, dry quickly, and help keep runners cool. Child participants should avoid oversized shirts.

Running Socks - Running Socks are important to avoid blisters on your feet, and thus they should be light and seamless, fit the shape of your feet, sweat-relieving and shock-absorbing.

Running Pants - Make sure you do NOT choose running pants that could hinder the movement of your legs.

Running Shoes - Make sure the toe area has enough room for your toes to stretch but not too wide. The top part of the shoe is best if it is made from soft and breathable materials. The heel should be firm and supportive. The sole should be nice and thick with good cushioning and support - arched support is even better. A sole with tread can keep you from slipping. Participants should also avoid wearing new shoes on race day.

Prevent bug bites - Use insect repellent on exposed parts of the body and clothing.

Gear Checklist



Tips for Child Participant's Parents/Guardian

Spare clothes for your little runner - Bring one more set of clothes for your child.

Preparation - Bring some snacks (e.g., biscuit, glucose candy) and a towel for your child.

Training – Parents and children can run gently as practice for 20-30 minutes every day before the race. Begin with interval training that alternates between running and walking to slowly work up to your target.

Warm up — Drink appropriate amount of room temperature water and do gentle stretch exercises before and after the race.

Prevent bug bites – To prevent bug bites, use DEET-containing insect repellents. For children, choose a DEET-containing insect repellent with lower concentration (less than 10%). When applying an insect repellent on young children, an adult should first apply it to their own hands to minimize the risk of allergic reactions. Avoid applying repellent to the child's hands, around the eyes or mouth, or on any cut or irritated skin. If re-application is needed, apply it to the child's clothing instead. Wash the child's skin where insect repellent has been applied, or bathe them after returning indoors. Also, wash any clothing that was exposed to insect repellent.

Post-race refreshment – To help the young children recover, ensure they replenish their fluids with plenty of water, eat bananas, and change into dry clothes. They should also rest as early as possible after retuning home that evening.

Security Checks

- 1. All Participants entering the event, along with their bags, clothing, parcels, and other items, may be subject to screening/security checks at the entrance and within the event center.
- 2. The Organizers reserve the right to restrict any bag, parcel, or other items from being brought into the event center, and to handle any unattended object in a manner they deem appropriate.
- 3. The use of handheld camera or cell phone extension poles (such as selfie sticks) is not permitted in the Start Zone, Racecourse, and the park. Please store your selfie sticks in your bag and deposit them at the Baggage Deposit Area.
- 4. Participants are advised to **reserve at least 45 minutes for Security Checking** to avoid congestion and possible delays.

Baggage Deposit Arrangement

- The Baggage Deposit counters are located inside the Event Center. "Mickey and Friends Junior Races" will be held inside the park without any Baggage Deposit counters.
- 2. The Organizers will ONLY handle the baggage with official baggage tags. In accordance with the new on disposable plastic products effective on April 22, 2024, baggage bags will not be provided or sold at the event center.

- · Notes to Wheelchair Participants
 - Race helmet is compulsory during the race for all wheelchair participants. Participants must ensure that no part of their lower limbs will touch the ground or the racecourse during the event and must take into account the safety of other participants on the route.

 - Only hand-operated, mechanical steering devices will be allowed:

Restroom Facilities

We recommend using the restroom before your race begins. Mobile toilet facilities will be available in the Event Center and along the course. For details on the locations of the Mobile toilet, please refer to page 10 – Event Center Floor Plan on Start Area Arrangement. Additional restroom facilities will also be available in the park. If you need assistance, please ask a Cast Member.

Competition Rules

The Start Point for the races (10K, 5K, 3K) are located at the Hong Kong Disneyland Coach Park. Cut-off points will be set up at different locations along the course. Participants who fail to reach the designated cut off points at a specific time will be asked by the Officials to retire from the course. For safety reasons, please line up in the Start Zone 15 minutes before your race begins. Additionally, after crossing the Finish line, participants are advised not to remain in the Finishing Area. Please be courteous and make space for others. Only participants can enter the starting area and the course.

Disney's Friends Cheer Squad

Different characters will appear along the route within the park, but there is a limited time to complete your races (10K-2hrs/5K-1.5hrs/3K-1hr). Your safety is our main concern; Officials will be deployed will be deployed along the course to direct event participants. To ensure an orderly fashion throughout the event, additional officials will be deployed at certain prime locations where runners may be most interested in taking photos. After the race, you can meet your friends and family at Hong Kong Disneyland and visit the Theme Park to celebrate your achievement. Participants must present a valid Park ticket for entry during the park operating hours. Upon entry to the Park, Guests are required to present his/her valid Park ticket. Ways to Recover After the Race

Stretching – Do not stop immediately after crossing the finish line. Runners should keep walking for a short distance after the race, followed by some light stretching to cool down.

Replenishment – Runners should replenish lost fluids, electrolytes, carbohydrates and proteins. Bananas and sport drinks are recommended.

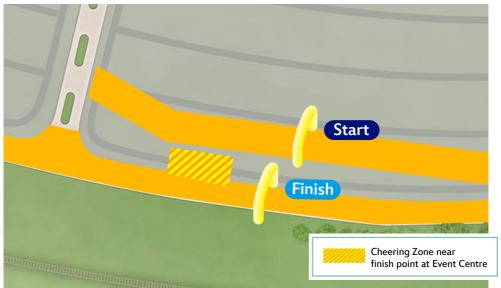
Ice Water Bath – After a long run, immerse sore muscles in cool water $(10 - 15^{\circ}C)$ for 10 - 15 minutes to help them recover.

Sleep or Massage – A 10-minutes doze on the bus/MTR or a 45 minutes sleep at home could bring complete refreshment. Participants may consider using massage cream on their legs to enhance blood circulation and ease muscle pain after the race.

Recovery – The week after the race, participants may begin a recovery run of around 20-30 minutes. Keep it at a moderate speed as jogging can enhance blood circulation and remove the lactic acid accumulated in your body, as well as feelings of fatigue. Low intensity cross training can be an option for recovery training.

Cheering Guide





Tip No.1 - Plan Ahead and Find the Best Cheering Location

The finish point and the Event Center are a good distance apart, and so it is best to pick your preferred cheering location before the event so that you won't miss the important moments on the day!

Tip No.2 – Tell the Runner where you are

Remember to tell the runners where you will be so that they won't miss you. While you are waiting, don't forget to cheer for other runners and Cast Members.

Release To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, each Participant releases and discharges the Organizers and any other individual, organization or company connected directly or indirectly with the Event or providing services or advices in relation to the Event from any and all losses, expenses, damages, claims, demands, compensation, causes of action and/or liabilities of every kind and nature, including, without limitation, attorneys' fees (collectively, "Liabilities") arising out of or in connection with the Event, including without limitation, Liabilities incurred during such training and preparation for the Event, during the Event, as a consequence of or while travelling to or from the Event, the collection, retention, transfer and use of my personal data, or the use of credit cards or other electronic gateways for payment.
 - 2.  - 4. Acceptance of Entries All Race entries are not transferable. Limited number of entries for each Race is available on a first-come, first-served basis. The Organizers do not accept any request for change after the Event online application is submitted. The Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any Participant or cancel his/her Race entry without refund or compensation if information provided in his/her Event online application (whether by the Participant or by an Applicant on his/her behalf) is false, incomplete or incorrect, or he/she fails to make the required payment or fails to meet all entry requirements.
